- We will use magnets to sort metals and find out how the shape of solid objects made from some materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching.

As Historians...

- We will look at how recycling in the UK and our local area has changed over the years
- We will also look at laws which have been introduced to protect our world and how politicians from other countries work together to help our world.

As musicians...

- We will play our own instruments to create a musical score
- In addition we will learn songs about taking care of our environment (Articles 29,31)

As Artists and Designers...

- We will use recyclable materials to design and create musical instruments linked to the text Ossiri and the Bala Mengo.
- We will salvage old pieces of cardboard and plastic and up-cycle them.
- We will need to select from a range of tools and equipment to be able to cut, shape, join and finish.(Articles 29, 31)

As Geographers...

We will look at oceans and continents and think about our responsibilities for those.

We will use geographical vocabulary to refer to physical features like forest, mountain, sea, ocean, river, soil, vegetation, season and weather.

We will look at the effect rubbish has on our physical environment.
