Art and Design - We are very fortunate to have an art and design studio and our children use this space for their art and design lessons. Our children enjoy a mixture of cross-curricular and discrete units of work and great use is made of cultural links and experiences.





Our children have the opportunity to work independently and in collaboration with others. Our art and design lessons facilitate the opportunity for peer feedback, where appropriate.



Within art, our children have the opportunity to interpret a range of work, express ideas and opinions about different pieces of art and to pose questions about the techniques used.



We learn about the works of others and complete artist studies. Our interpretations inspire our own designs and art work.



Through art, children are encouraged to take risks and experiment with techniques, colour, line work and texture. A culture of exploration is fostered and rather than tell children how to achieve their desired outcome, we facilitate opportunities for trial and error.





Our children are immersed in sensory, visual and tactile experiences as part of their learning in art.





As the children progress through school, their skills develop. We photograph their art work and upload to their online journals in EYFS and in KS1 and KS2, our children document their work and progress in their art sketchbooks.
