Music - Our music curriculum follows the Charanga scheme of work. This ensures that our children enjoy broad and balanced opportunities.



Through our music curriculum, our children enjoy opportunities to play tuned and untuned instruments. The children have opportunities to compose their own pieces as well as playing familiar tunes.



We make purposeful use of technology to compose music - our children have iPads and use GarageBand to explore technological advances. This also provides our children with the opportunity to explore a wider range of instruments and to manipulate their outcomes.



We follow the Charanga scheme of work as this provides clear progression for our children. They enjoy opportunities to play instruments, compose music and to learn and perform songs. They also develop evaluation skills.



In addition to the music curriculum delivered within lessons, our children also access weekly singing assemblies, have opportunities to sing in a choir and to learn musical instruments. They use many of the skills learnt in class when performing at various points in their school careers.



Our children also develop a historical understanding of music - learning about great composers as well as the ways in which music production has changed with new and innovative technologies.



One of our main priorities is to broaden our children's vocabulary. We intend for our children to become vocabulary rich and so we immerse them in appropriate technical vocabulary in music.
